Through his passion for the art of dance he wanted to highlight various means of enslavement through the centuries of American History and evoke thought and conversation. He has woven together the work of four poets (Marier Cooper's My World My Eyes, Elhondra Brazzle & Shaddai Johnson's Post Traumatic Slave Syndrome, and Teday the Brave's There Was a Lynching) and the instrumental of Nina Simone's Strange Fruit to paint a picture of our past iniquities, present struggles, and future burdens. As you watch this work keep those things in mind and know that the goal is not to inflict more trauma or controversy but to elicit a need to answer this question: Since we are all in some ways bystanders to enslavement, the fight for justice, and the many people who's stories end along the way, what can we do to end the cycle of simply standing back and watching?


