Each year our recital is dedicated to a significant person or group of individuals who have had an impact on my progress personally or the progress and richness of Martell School of Dance.


This year, the spotlight shines on an extremely valuable group of people who often walk silently among us or witness our successes from afar.

It seems like I blinked and suddenly you have been dancing for ten years.

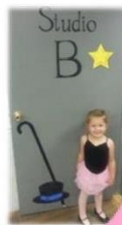
